VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS

BYLAW NO. 431, 2016

A Bylaw of the Village of Port Clements to provide for the borrowing of money in anticipation of revenue.

The Council for the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

Whereas:

- Α. The Village of Port Clements (the "Municipality") may not have sufficient money on hand to meet the current lawful expenditures of the Municipality;
- B. Section 177 of the Community Charter permits the Council, without any further approval, consent or assent to borrow money necessary to
 - (a) meet current lawful expenditures, and
 - (b) pay amounts required to meet the Municipality's taxing obligations in relation to another local government or other public body:
- C. The Municipality's outstanding debt for the purposes of Section 177 must not exceed the total of:
 - (a) the unpaid taxes for all purposes imposed during the current year (deemed to be 75% of all taxes imposed for all purposes in the preceding year), and
 - (b) the money remaining due from other governments.
- D. The unpaid taxes calculated as 75% of all taxes imposed for all purposes for the 2015 tax year are \$232,068.00 and the money remaining due from other governments is \$0 totaling \$232,068.00 the total representing the maximum amount that may be borrowed under this bylaw.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council for the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled, **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS**:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as "The Village of Port Clements Revenue Anticipation Borrowing Bylaw No. 431, 2016".
- 2. The Council is authorized to borrow upon the credit of the Municipality from the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce an amount or amounts not exceeding the sum of two hundred thirty two thousand sixty eight dollars. (\$232,068.00), as may be required and to pay interest thereon at the prime rate of the Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce.
- 3. The form of obligation to be given as acknowledgment of the liability shall be a promissory note or notes, or an overdraft agreement bearing the corporate seal and signed by the Mayor and the CAO.
- 4. Bylaw #427, 2015 is hereby repealed.

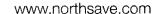

Re: Vibrant Communities Program

While we are very pleased that Gwaii Trust announced the Vibrant Communities program at the end of 2015, when we began to really look at it for implementation in 2016 several challenges came to light.

It was originally thought that this funding would be for municipal purposes, a thought that was supported by the program release which spoke very clearly about infrastructure. We have since been advised that this money is for municipalities and not-for-profits and that apparently it will cover core funding, which is rarely ever funded, making it extremely valuable to not-for-profits. We have also noted that while Old Massett and Skidegate each received a set amount, Graham Island North, Central and South are required to share their amounts with the unincorporated areas within their respective geographic areas decreasing the amount available to those communities and thereby reducing the equity of this program.

This information creates challenges which need to be resolved.

1. If the Municipalities are to decide whether the funding is used for our purposes or not-for-profit purposes this puts us in a conflict of interest position. While we may not get legally called on this situation, it definitely has the potential to create hard feelings within the community and leaves us vulnerable to a lawsuit. As we already know in Port Clements, it costs a lot of money to defend yourself, even if you are eventually proven correct, because Conflict of Interest for Municipalities is a Supreme Court issue and can't be decided by a lesser means. It also negates one of the attractions of year over year funding. One of the values of secured funding is that it allows Municipalities to attempt to leverage other funding. However if it is unknown from year to year whether the funding will go to the Municipality or a not-for-profit then this usefulness has been taken away.

2. The funding split in the three Graham island areas has not been predetermined. While Port Clements has traditionally split the Christmas Fund with Tlell in a 30/70 split this very split has now been called into question as to its accurateness which can happen when more money is involved. In addition there has been concern raised about "who" the governing body is for the various unincorporated areas on Haida Gwaii which further confounds where permission is to be sought.

Here are some of our thoughts on increasing the functionality of this funding program.

- 1. Allot \$250,000/year to each of the communities (Old Massett, Masset, Port Clements, Skidegate, Queen Charlotte AND the Regional District). This arrangement eliminates problem #2 because it clearly delineates by community and makes the Regional District, which is the governing body for the unincorporated areas, responsible for their own projects and not involved in municipal projects. The Regional District can then determine what format their approvals will take (whether by geographic area or as a total or whatever scheme they settle upon). This may be able to be accomplished without changing your budget as you have some funding left over from the recent Major Infrastructure call which can be reallocated. Alternatively, if there are not enough remaining funds from Major Infrastructure, you could simply change your budget. The Trust has never been overly concerned in the past about changing its budget midstream.
- 2. Have Gwaii Trust be the authorizing body for the applications, which resolves part of the concern in #1 above, and, further, if you really wish to make this available to not-for-profits, make a hard split by dollar or percentage so everyone is clear from the start what they are annually entitled to, so that the year over year guaranteed funding once again has the value it should.

Thank you for considering our concerns. We hope that a quick resolution can occur as Port Clements has a project in the wings which we would really like to finish before mid-May.

Re: Local Government Management Exchange Program

Background: Each year the Local Government Management Association of BC (LGMA) in conjunction with the New Zealand Society of Local Government Managers (SOLGM) facilitate a professional exchange program for Municipal Administrators. An administrator from a BC Municipality spends two weeks as a guest at a Municipality in New Zealand and vice versa. The program exists to provide a forum for the exchange of skills, competencies and knowledge and enhance the career development of each of the participants. Interested Administrators must submit a proposal which outlines their learning objectives, areas of interest, how they will share the knowledge gained from the exchange with other BC Administrators and identifies how this experience will support their own professional development. The successful candidate will then spend two weeks in New Zealand as a guest of a Municipality there in September 2016 and then that Municipality will send a guest to the candidates' community for two weeks in May 2017. Travel is covered by LGMA and SOLGM and the candidates will stay in the home of their counterparts.

Included with the application is a resolution from Council verifying that they support the application and that they will grant the Administrator time off with pay to participate in this event. If the Municipality wishes to undertake any additional activities related to this exchange that must be spelled out in the application.

Deadline for the applications is April 22, 2016.

Costs to the Municipality will include two weeks' time off with pay for the Administrator in September as well as acknowledging that for two weeks the following May the Administrator will be spending a significant amount of time with the visiting Administrator which would impact their duties. There may be some travel costs associated with visiting other communities on Haida Gwaii with the visiting Administrator. Attendance at the 2017 LGMA conference is mandatory – however annual attendance at this event is something that is already in the Administrator's contract so that is not an additional expense. The Administrator will personally incur the cost of housing and feeding the visiting person.
