2. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the Village of Port Clements 5 year Capital Expenditure Program for the years 1995-1999.

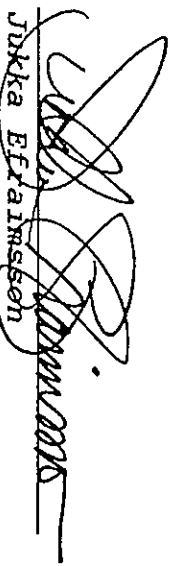
