

VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS
REFERENDUM BYLAW No. 165

A bylaw to authorize a referendum to receive the opinion of the electors regarding the purchase of a Tanker Truck and an Air Compressor for the Port Clements Volunteer Fire Department.

WHEREAS the existing Tanker Truck is beyond economical repair;

AND WHEREAS in order to retain our fire rating for insurance purposes Fire Underwriters Survey require that the Village have a Tanker Truck with certain minimum capabilities;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to purchase a compressor to fill the required air tanks;

AND WHEREAS Selkirk College has agreed to supply a completely refurbished Tanker Truck to the Village for approximately \$25,000 and the compressor can be purchased for approximately \$6,000 and \$4,000 for costs incidental to.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The following question is to be submitted to the electorate at the time of the 1985 Municipal Election:

"Do you agree to Council borrowing on the credit of the Municipality a sum not to exceed \$35,000, with repayment over a period not exceeding fifteen years for the purchase of a Tanker Truck and Air Compressor for the Port Clements Volunteer Fire Department?"

2. This bylaw shall be cited as the "Village of Port Clements Referendum Bylaw No. 165, 1985".

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 07 day of October, 1985.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 07 day of October, 1985.

READ A THIRD TIME THIS 07 day of October, 1985.

RECONSIDERED AND FINALLY ADOPTED THIS 15 day of October, 1985.

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
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
