

VILLAGE OF PORT CLEMENTS

BY-LAW NO. 226

A By-Law to authorize the borrowing for the estimated cost of digging and equipping a new water well, purchasing and installing a new ozonation water treatment system and constructing a pigging system to clean village water lines.

WHEREAS the village has two wells which supply water to the Village;

AND WHEREAS the screening at the bottom of the Number 1 Well has rusted through and collapsed;

AND WHEREAS the Number 1 Well now pumps up water which contains high amounts of sediment including manganese;

AND WHEREAS the sediment in the water results in a strain on the pumps and causes them to break down;

AND WHEREAS the company which manufactured the Villages current ozonator has gone bankrupt thereby making spare parts expensive and difficult to locate;

AND WHEREAS the Village water lines have accumulated, and continue to accumulate an unacceptable amount of sediment including manganese;

AND WHEREAS the sludge in the water lines ends up being drawn through service lines into homes and businesses in the Village;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable and necessary to dig and equip a new water well, to purchase and install a new ozonation water treatment system and to construct a pigging system to clean the water lines servicing the Village of Port Clements;

AND WHEREAS the estimated cost of constructing the above mentioned works, including expenses incidental thereto is the sum of \$ 150,000 which is the amount of debt intended to be created by this by-law;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the assessed value for General Municipal purposes of the taxable land and improvements for the current year and for each of the two years immediately preceding the current year were:

1989: \$11,005,435

1990: \$10,989,551

1991: \$13,257,249

AND WHEREAS the amount of authorized debenture debt of the Municipality is \$ 1,166,469 of which \$ 1,166,469 is existing outstanding debenture debt and \$ NIL is authorized and unissued debenture debt, and none of the principal or interest of the debenture debt of the Municipality is in arrears.

AND WHEREAS the approval of the Provincial Health Officer has been obtained;

AND WHEREAS the maximum term for which debentures may be issued to secure the debt created by this by-law is 25 years;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Port Clements in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. The Council is hereby empowered and authorized to undertake and carry out or cause to be carried out the construction of a water distribution system generally in accordance with general plans approved by the Provincial health Officer and to do things necessary in connection therewith and without limiting the generality of the foregoing:

- a) To borrow upon the credit of the Municipality a sum not exceeding \$ 150,000;
- b) To acquire all such real property, easements, rights or authorities that may be requisite or desirable in connection with the construction of the said water well, ozonator, and pigging system.

2. This By-Law may be cited as the "Water System Improvement Loan Authorization By-Law No. 226, 1990".
