Minutes of the Vibrant Community Commission Meeting, Wednesday, July 28, 2021

Meeting Called to Order at 7:10pm

Councilor Whitney-Gould: I call to order this meeting of the Vibrant Community Commission being held on the traditional territory of the Haida People.

4. BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES & UNFINISHED BUSINESS

B-1: Presentation and Overview by J. Breese.

Julia Breese presented on the scope of work to develop a tourism website for the Village of Port Clements. The objective in developing the website is to generate longer stays in the community, give visitors reasons to come to the community, and support local business. The work is to be completed in three phases:

Phase One: Research and Discovery

Phase Two: Visual Brand and Website Design

Phase Three: Voice and Tone and Social Media Campaign

Contract deliverables are to be completed by 31st December 2021. Feedback from the community will be sought from 10-15 key stakeholders by invitation. The purpose is to ensure the website broadly reflects the needs of the community in achieving the objectives of local tourism development. The scope of work will be submitted to the Village Council to keep them informed on progress.

B-2: Verbal Report: Request for Proposal for Tourism Advocate 2021-07-049—Motion to receive verbal report moved by Christine Cunningham, seconded by Ian Gould.

The Chair provided a brief update, reporting that the first and second RFP failed to find a suitable candidate for the scope of work. Rather than extend the RFP for a third time, the decision was to proceed with restricting the projects to the development of the Swimming Hole given the limited time remaining on the Gwaii Trust grant.

B-3: Verbal Report: Update on the Vibrant Community Grant 2021-07-050—Motion to receive verbal report moved by Christine Cunningham, seconded by Ian Gould.


The Chair provided a brief update, noting that the last change of scope application to the Gwaii Trust had been lost. It has now been 'received' with an end date of 31st December 2021 at which time all work is to be completed. As we were not able to find a suitable applicant the RFP process, the funding attached to some of the projects will now have to be revised and another scope of change application will have to be submitted in September or October.

B-4: Verbal Report and Discussion: Work Plan / Scope of Work 2021 2021-07-051— Motion to receive verbal report moved by lan Gould, seconded by Christine Cunningham.

The Chair provided a brief update on the status of the swimming hole development. A brief onsite visit was held with Public Works the week of July 19th to ensure the placement of the change shack and gazebo and potentially an outhouse raised none or limited maintenance concerns. A discussion to finalize the placement of the two benches, the fire ring (supplied by Public Works), the change shack, the gazebo, and the outhouse determined the following:

- Change shack will be located at the side of the main trail heading down to the shore
- Two benches will be located at a single fire pit (tree liming required)
- Gazebo (6 sided / 12' across / shingled, double roof) to be located in the open area toward the trees (north)
- Outhouse (funding dependent) will be located in the upper parking lot



The objective is to build an attractive and functional gazebo with a built-in central table (see sample photo). Support from residents living near or across from the swimming hole will be solicited by letter, hand delivered by Christine Cunningham. The letter will highlight the benefit of the development as:

- a safe and clean place for families
- day use only (signage)
- no parking on highway (signage)
- garbage and washroom facilities nearby
- trail beautification
- removal of brush and some trees will improve ocean views

B-5: Verbal Report and Discussion: Grant to Support Port Clements Museum 2021-07-052—Motion to receive verbal report moved by Ian Gould, seconded by Christine Cunningham.
