

What's new in Emergency Management for Haida Gwaii?

In 2017 all the communities on Island implemented an island wide emergency mass communication system powered by the ePACT Network. This is 'Haida Gwaii Alerts'. It is based on resident "opt-in" and it is at no cost to residents. Residents just create an on-line profile and submit the information they want to include such as medical issues and/or special needs.

It is a system based on redundancy in case one method of alerting fails. Therefore alerts to residents come in the form of emails, texts and phone calls.

It meets or exceeds Federal and Provincial privacy legislation and all data is backed up in Canada.

We tested this system with the Provincial "Shake Out" exercise in 2017 and Queen Charlotte put the system to task when dealing with a landslide. In early 2018 the system was tested Island-wide with the Tsunami alert. Overall the results were good, but feedback helps work out any problems with the new system.

Important Reminder!

After December 31st 2018 all unpaid taxes rolled over into 2019 and collect daily interest in 2019. All unpaid current taxes for 2018 became arrear taxes for 2019. All unpaid arrears taxes in 2018 became delinguent taxes in 2019. All unpaid delinguent taxes will have the property go up for tax sale in September if not paid in full before the tax sale deadline. Also, please note that all unpaid utility balances for 2018 were also transferred into the tax account as arrear taxes for 2019.

This grant provides 50% reimbursement to a maximum of \$5000 for the cost of eligible improvements. The improvement project must have a minimum value of \$1500. Wayfinding signage is available for 50% reimbursement up to a maximum of \$500. If you have previously applied and received the grant but did not use up the maximum \$5000 you can re-apply for the remaining balance.
