

# Don't Forget! Sign up to the Haida Gwaii ePACT Network

The Port Clements and Island Emergency Management Committees continue to train and review services to better serve our residents.

Last year all the communities on Island adopted and implemented the committees recommendation of an island wide emergency mass communication system powered by the ePACT Network. This is 'Haida Gwaii Alerts'. It is based on resident "optin" and it is at no cost to residents. Residents just create an on-line profile and submit the information they want to include such as medical issues

It is a system based on redundancy in case one method fails. Therefore alerts to residents come in the form of emails, texts and phone messages.

It meets or exceeds Federal and Provincial privacy legislation and all data is backed up in Canada.

We tested this system with the Provincial "Shake Out" exercise in October last year and Queen Charlotte put the system to task when dealing with their landslide. This year the system was tested with the Tsunami alert. Overall the results were good, but feedback helps work out any problems with the new system.

# **Business Façade Improvement Program 2018**

Created to support local businesses in an effort to renovate, refurbish and improve their business exteriors, this program provides a grant to local businesses and property owners to improve their business exteriors within specific commercial areas of Port Clements.

#### Eligible Areas

Highway Commercial Strip: #2-7 Grouse Street

#85-211 Adams Avenue

#2-10 Newcombe Avenue

Downtown Core: #41-124 Bayview Drive

#1-11 Yakoun Street

This grant provide 50% reimbursement to a maximum of \$5000 for the cost of eligible improvements. The improvement project must have a minimum value of \$1500. Wayfinding signage is available for 50% reimbursement up to a maximum of \$500.

# **Home Owner's Grant 2018 Reminder**

FREE MONEY! The Home Owner's Grant (HOG) is a provincial grant given to property owners to reduce their property tax burden, which means the owner can keep the money they would have otherwise paid out in taxes.

To apply simply fill out the 2018 HOG form and submit it to the Village Office for processing. This form is on the back of the 2018 tax notice, though the Village Office has another version to fill out if the tax notice is misplaced or submitted to the Village Office without the HOG filled out.

Home owners have until December 31st, 2018 to apply. The HOG must be claimed and the remaining tax balance paid in full before July 3rd, 2018 to avoid a 10% penalty being applied.

If the 2017 HOG was not claimed, then a retroactive HOG can be applied for. Please contact the Village Office for details.

# The More You Know: Delegations to Council

Do you have an idea or concern that a letter to Council may not capture? Want to be a delegation to Council instead?

The full rules are detailed in the Village's Procedure Bylaw, but the simplified process is as follows:

- 1. Fill out the delegation application form and provide any accompanying documents that may be required at the Village Office. Do this by **Wednesday at 1:00 PM** before the Council Meeting.
- The application is screened by staff to confirm that it is within municipal jurisdiction and is an item that needs to go before Council.
- 3. If the delegation passes screening it is either confirmed for the upcoming Council Meeting or is put to another meeting.
- 4. The delegation attends the Council Meeting and is **limited to 10 minutes to speak to Council**.
