


What's New in Port Clements: Updates on Projects

Fire Hall Re-Enveloping Project

The Port Clements Volunteer Fire Department re-enveloping project is still underway. To date, the roof has been completed. The siding continues to be worked on. Thanks to Sharoon Services for their work on the project and to Gwaii Trust Major Contributions Grant & Council for making this happen.



Sewer Lagoon Survey

Survey crews were in Port Clements to survey the leased land for future municipal sewer expansion. Expansion adjacent to existing sewer lagoon.



Well Drilling

Well drilling in Port Clements to establish a new well to secure reliable source of water. Western water hydrogeological crew sampling the soil to determine if it's adequate for ideal water infiltration.



Community Park Bathrooms
