

Don't Forget! Sign up to the Haida Gwaii ePACT Network

In 2017 all the communities on Island implemented an island wide emergency mass communication system powered by the ePACT Network. This is 'Haida Gwaii Alerts'. It is based on resident "opt-in" and it is at no cost to residents. Residents just create an on-line profile and submit the information they want to include such as medical issues and/or special needs.

It is a system based on redundancy in case one method of alerting fails. Therefore alerts to residents come in the form of emails, texts and phone calls.

It meets or exceeds Federal and Provincial privacy legislation and all data is backed up in Canada.

We tested this system with the Provincial "Shake Out" exercise in 2017 and Queen Charlotte put the system to task when dealing with a landslide. In early 2018 the system was tested Island-wide with the Tsunami alert. Overall the results were good, but feedback helps work out any problems with the new system.

VOTING DATES AND LOCATIONS

GENERAL VOTING will be open to qualified electors of the Village of Port Clements on: Saturday, October 20, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm in the Senior's Room at the Multi-Purpose Building located

ADVANCE VOTING will be available to qualified electors as follows: Wednesday, October 10, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm in the Senior's Room at the Multi-Purpose Building located at 36 Cedar Avenue West, Port Clements, BC.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Village of Port Clements for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident property electors must produce 2 pieces of identification (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, proof that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, written consent from the other property owners.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Qualified electors may vote by mail if they:

- have a physical disability, illness or injury that affects their ability to vote at another voting
- expect to be absent from the Village of Port Clements on general voting day and at the times of all advance voting opportunities.

REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

Before 4 pm on October 5, 2018 you must submit an "Application to Vote by Mail" to the Village of Port Clements by mail to P.O. Box 198, Port Clements, BC VOT 1R0; or fax 250-557-4568 or email cao@portclements.ca:

- Full name
- Residential address,
- Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
- Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - pick up at Village of Port Clements office, OR
 regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package, and
- 5. If you are not on the list of electors, to ensure you receive the correct registration application form in your package, you must indicate whether you are going to be registering as a resident or non-

The Village will send out mail ballot packages commencing on or about September 24, 2018. To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8 pm on Saturday,

#41-124 Bayview Drive #1-11 Yakoun Street




Remember to stay safe this Halloween season!
