PROJECT UPDATES

The Village of Port Clements has updates on various projects that are ongoing in 2022. There are 33 Strategic Plan targets and initiatives for this year; this is a highlight of some of the projects in progress.

Sewer Lagoon Project burning of the wood debris continues to be underway.

Sunset Park Revitalization Project is progressing with contractors working on the bridges and bird tower using processed wood held back from the Sewer Lagoon project.

Public Works Yard Improvement Project an extension has been receive for this project from grant funding agency, continued issues sourcing contractors for cement pad and installation of the public works yard building have delayed project.

Water Treatment Plant Upgrades well #3 connection is still in progress.

The Coastal Erosion and Flood Mapping Study, a regional partnership, is still in progress but has experienced delays, expected to be completed in January 2023.

Golden Spruce Trail Extension Study is near completion with report being finalized, expected completion in December 2022.

As per the Villag'es Snow and Ice Removal Policy No. 23, 2022, the Village maintains municipal streets in a safe and passable condition to assist vehicles that are properly equipped for winter driving, being operated using good winter practices, and pedestrians using the roadways with proper winter footwear.

It is that time of the year again! The Port Bucks program has returned for another year. The Port Buck can be used in any participating business in Port Clements or Tlell.

Households on Nadu Road and households in the Regional District just outside of Port Clements' Village boundaries can pick up their Port Buck directly from the Port Clements Village Office. Renters in Port Clements who are a separate household from their landlord and do not receive the Port Buck in the utilities bill, can also pick up their Port Buck from the Village Office.

Proof of residence and valid id will need to be presented to staff as well as signing our tracking sheet will be required in order to pick up a Port Buck.

Port Bucks are valid until December 31st, 2022.
