BACKGROUND:

The Sandspit Community Society has organized the Loggers Sports Days in Sandspit for several years. In recent years they have sent out a request for a donation from local businesses and individuals for the event to offset its costs.

In 2018 and 2019, Council donated \$500 to the event, but has not donated since.

DISCUSSION:

The Sandspit Community Society is a non-profit society that operates on Haida Gwaii, and as such, per the Village's *Donations Policy* they could be awarded up to a maximum donation of \$250 if it is available in the budget allocated for donations. However, Council is not obligated to provide donations and can turn down such requests as it sees fit.

For 2023 Council set an annual budget of \$1,000 for donations, of which \$500 has already been distributed.

CONCLUSION:

It is Council's discretion to provide a donation or not for the Sandspit Community Society for their logger's sports day event.


