

PROJECT UPDATES

The Village of Port Clements has updates on various projects that are ongoing in 2024. This is a highlight of some of the projects in progress.

Sewer Lagoon Project the projected costs of construction are estimated to go above the budget for the project. The Village is exploring options on how to handle this potential increase. Tendering of the sewer lagoon project is expected to be released in early 2024.

Sunset Park Revitalization Project the project is substantially completed, with moving into project reporting and finalization of a few items (ex. Sunset Park brochure).

Community Park Improvement Project most of the work is completed. However, work on the fencing and other areas needs to be completed by March 2024.

Public Works Yard Improvement Project work on cement pad and erecting storage building continue to be delayed due to workload pressures.

Well #3 Project the contract to complete the project has been awarded to Canadian Western Mechanical. Work is expected to begin soon.

Official Community Plan Work on maps for document still in progress, otherwise close to completion.

GENERAL NEW YEARS REMINDERS

We are well underway into a new year. While reminder letters and notices went out at the end of last year, here is a general reminder that there are annual licenses and membership fees for services that are operated by the Village that must be renewed at this time.

- As required by bylaw, anyone operating a business within the Village is required to have a business licence (this includes airbnbs), the current annual licence fee is \$30.
- Weightroom memberships cost \$120 for a year (though it is prorated and not a flat fee except at the start of the year).
 An annual waiver must be signed as well as completion of an orientation.
- A Fire Protection Agreement is \$150 for a year. Do you have a property outside of municipal boundaries that is within the Port Clements fire protection service area? If so, unless you have a Fire Protection Agreement with the Village in place, if the Village's Fire Department attends to your property there will be a \$250/hour charge (or the current charge of the Provincial Emergency Programs call out rate, whichever is higher)

KEEP AN EYE OUT FOR LEAKS!

As temperatures fluctuate between warm to freezing, it is a good idea to regularly review your property to check your pipes for potential leaks.

A leak may not be immediately noticeable. There may not be a fluctuating loss of pressure, minor loss of pressure, or complete loss of pressure that you may expect to see with leaks. Leaks can be hidden so it is important to inspect your pipes visually and be vigilant.

Additionally, a big thank you again to all residents who inspected their water pipes during our deterioration event in January that the Village experienced. Without resident's understanding, patience, due diligence and efforts the situation may have continued and become an emergency event requiring shut off of the system.
