The official invitation has gone out so you should have received it from Minister Rankin's office (it is also below).

I just wanted to get in touch directly as well because the Province and CHN would be honoured to have someone representing the Village of Port Clements say a few words at the event. There will be a number of dignitaries from the provincial government attending and speaking, as well as from the Haida Nation and the other local governments on the islands.

I will follow up in a day or two to see if you have someone who can speak at the event, as well as to confirm who will attend as elected representatives so that we can follow appropriate protocols. I can also share an agenda as soon as it is ready.

This is an open event to all people on Haida Gwaii, so please feel free to share the invitation or poster with staff in the village office and others in your community as well.
